Guidelines for authorship on papers arising from work conducted by the Mental Health and Illicit Drug use Disorders Expert Groups

Expert group members

Group authorship

We wish to adhere to international guidelines for authorship (see below). We also wish to use a group author format to acknowledge the input of core expert group members in the process even if they do not meet criteria for individual authorship. All Expert Group members will be individually acknowledged (as members of the Group) in all publications arising from directly out of the work on the project, irrespective of whether they meet criteria for individual authorship on the publication. We will use a group author as follows: **the global burden of disease expert group on mental health and illicit drug use disorders**. Core expert group members will be listed as part of this group in acknowledgement sections.

Individual authorship

For individual authorship we seek to be in accordance with guidelines developed by the International Committee of Medical Journal Editors, which has recommended **the following criteria for authorship** (<http://www.icmje.org/>):

- 1) substantial contributions to conception and design, or acquisition of data, or analysis and interpretation of data;
- 2) drafting the article or revising it critically for important intellectual content; and
- 3) final approval of the version to be published.

Conditions 1, 2, and 3 must all be met. Acquisition of funding, the collection of data, or general supervision of the research group, by themselves, do not justify authorship. Authors should provide a description of what each contributed, and editors should publish that information.

Co-Chairs

1. The Co-Chairs of the Expert Group will be individually acknowledged as such in all papers involving work derived from the GBD exercise as part of the group authorship.
2. If a Co-Chair has provided sufficient input into a publication such that they meet the criteria above, they will be listed as an individual author.

Corresponding expert group members

The GBD teams may consult with the corresponding members for aspects of the work being carried out. We will acknowledge corresponding group members individually in Acknowledgement sections if they have provided some level of advice to the paper's work but do not satisfy full criteria for authorship.

If Corresponding Members have provided sufficient input to satisfy criteria for authorship as outlined above, they will be invited to join any peer reviewed publications as an individual author.

Research teams working with the Expert Group Co-Chairs

Multiple researchers are anticipated to be involved with the work required to complete the tasks asked of the Expert Group.

If a researcher is employed to work on the GBD project in a dedicated fashion, they will be individually listed in Acknowledgement sections for their contribution to the project irrespective of whether they have materially contributed to a specific paper.

If a researcher has contributed to a paper such that their input satisfies international authorship criteria (listed above), they will be individually listed as an author.
